ABOUT OUR SCHOOL

- We are a 3 form entry school and currently have 597 children on roll
- Our catchment area for Reception 2018/19 was just under 2 miles
- We have an intake of 90 children per year which included 40 siblings this year.
- We offer a breakfast club facility from 7:50am to the start of the school day at a cost of £3.50 per session
- After school care is provided on the school site by Play 4 Ages until 6:00pm at a cost of £12.00 per session
- SPS offers over 50 clubs to the children, including a wide range of activities and sports
- Our parent association (SPSA) is always busy raising money for our school to benefit the facilities that your child has access to. Last year we raised an amazing amount of money through many events such as: Spring Ball and our Summer Fair to name but a few!

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- Reception applications are for children born between 1st September 2014 and 31st August 2015

- You can apply online from Monday 5th November 2018. Applications close on Tuesday 15th January 2019.
- You can apply for up to 3 schools, putting them in order of preference. It is in your best interests to list 3 schools. Naming only one does not guarantee your child a place at that school or give your child priority for a place over another child.
- If you apply online KCC will email you on 16th April after 4:00pm to tell you which school you have been offered.

Criteria

SPS will rank the list of children provided by KCC in March by the criteria below. We do not know if you have put us down as your preferred school.

- Children in Local Authority Care (LAC)
- Current Family Association (Sibling)
- Health, Social and Special Access Reasons
- Nearness of child's home to school (Distance)
