## The Year 6 Curriculum

This is an exciting and memorable year for pupils. Although perceived to be dominated by hard work and testing, there is much more to the final year of primary school than that! ## Procedure for Secondary Education (PESE)

The date of the Kent Tests (11+) themselves is yet to confirmed. Parents / carers can be notified of the outcome of these tests via email if they so wish, otherwise the results will be via post, (this is also to be confirmed. If you have any questions about the application process, please contact the office and they will be happy to help you out.

For those children who will be undertaking the tests, it is vital that all Year 5 work is kept neat, safe and easily accessible in case it is needed for Kent Test appeals. For this reason, all files will be kept at school.

Those children not sitting the tests will undertake other curriculum activities.

## Blackland Farm Residential School Trip

This eagerly anticipated outward-bound trip has been postponed, but do not fret, as we have a provisional date booked which are awaiting confirmation of. ## Statutory Assessment Tests (SATs)
