Meet Connor.

He is a boisterous, fun loving, and loud 4 year old.

Except that Connor has been diagnosed with Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy. Which you may never have heard of but there are only two things you need to know.

Firstly, that the outlook for a child with Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy isn't great; it causes muscle degeneration and significantly reduces life expectancy.

Secondly, there is no cure.

Research is underway for both enhanced therapy and a cure. It's vital for Connor and boys like him, that these projects receive funding to continue and accelerate their development.
