Dear Parents / Carers

In light of the recent statement from the Government, the school will close on Friday 20th March 2020, until further notice. As a staff, it is our ambition that we will offer continuous education provision to our pupils via our KLZ portal. The detail around this provision was sent out earlier this week.

In order to establish if we can provide a child care service for key workers' children, I need to know by **12.00 noon on Thursday 19th March** if you are a key worker e.g. NHS staff, or if you have a child with an Education Health Care Plan (EHCP) and feel you would want them to be in school (for a childcare style provision). As I am sure you will be aware, we have many staff affected by this situation, so if your spouse/ partner is not a key worker, we would ask that your children remained at home to ensure that our numbers are manageable.

We may well need to work with a partner school in Sevenoaks to provide a childcare service that identified pupils from local schools may attend, at which some of our staff may work on certain days of the week, alongside staff from other schools. As key workers ourselves, we will need to be able to ensure our own children have appropriate childcare arrangements.
